Meeting Minutes For Tuesday, October 24, 2011

The W.C.Y.A.A. Board met on Tuesday, October 25, at the W.C.Y.A.A. offices in Lucama. Those in attendance were as follows: Kevin Henry (EC), Robert "Peanut" Sharpe (EC), Chad Braddy (RR), Michael Best (Lucama), Mickey Davis (Lucama), Archie Aycock (Saratoga), and Ellie Aycock (Saratoga). Lee Woodard was not represented.

Topics discussed:

Mickey moved games in the 8U BB, 9-10 BB, and 11-12 BB age divisions due to the fall festivals on Thursday night, October 27, at Lucama Elementary And Rock Ridge Elementary Schools. The coaches of the opposing teams will be called by Chad Braddy (8U), Archie Aycock (Saratoga), and Peanut Sharpe (EC).

Mickey told the board that the offices were moving to the Wilson County Tax Office Building in Wilson. The address is 113 East Nash Street. We will have two offices on the fifth floor. There will be no rent or utilities charges for either office. The move will be effective November 1st.

The fall soccer season is coming to an end. Soccer will be completed in three weeks, girl's volleyball in two weeks, and BB/SB next week.

Mickey met with Tommy Finch, Facilities Director, and the new Wilson County School Board Superintendent, Mr. Bulson, on Monday afternoon to discuss the upcoming basketball season and the use of the gymnasiums. Mickey asked that he be allowed to open and close the gymnasiums for the upcoming basketball season to save the \$40.00 fees each date. Mickey is considered a permanent part-time employee for Wilson County and could be bonded. Mr. Bulson said they would get back up Mickey shortly after speaking to the board. The total savings to the six W.C.Y.A.A. communities would be over \$8,000.00.

Mickey discussed the upcoming basketball season at length. Please note the important dates are listed below:

- 1) Registrations start Saturday, November 29.
- 2) Registrations will end on Sunday, November 27.
- 3) **Paperwork and fees including the \$5.000 out of county fees are due Thursday, December 1. Individual forms and roster sheets are due. All coaches must be listed on the roster sheet.**
- 4) Saturday, December 3, 8:00am.....Schedule Meeting.....One representative from each community is needed.
- 5) Monday, December 5.....Schedules will be posted on the website. This will include all coaches phone numbers and sponsor's names.
- 6) **Saturday, December 10.....W.C.Y.A.A. 2011-2012 Jamboree Day at Rock Ridge Elementary School. All age divisions will participate. No score will be kept on the scoreboard but all other regular season rules will be used. Mickey will furnish reversible jerseys for the Jamboree.**
- 7) Saturday, December 17.....First Regular Season Games will be played.

The registration fee will be \$45.00 for all age divisions.

Boy's Age Divisions: 2-4 Co-ed Instructional, 5-6 Co-ed, 8U, 9-10 Boys, 12U, 13-15, and 16-18

Girl's Age Divisions: 9U and 13U

The Birthdate cutoff for both the boys and girls age division will be December 1, 2011. Example: A 10 year old turns 11 before December 1, 2011, he must play 12U. If he turns 11 after December 1, 2011, he can still play in the 10U age division.

Players may still register at Omega Sports in Wilson during store hours. Omega Sports is located in the Heritage Crossing Center. Players must pay at the time of registration.

Two sites will be used each Saturday during the regular season. There could be Friday games and Sunday games if needed. Communities with the largest amount of teams will receive the most home dates.

Reminder: There must be at least three teams in an age division to form a division. We will not make a schedule with two teams. Once signups are over, if a age division only has two teams, all registrations fees will be reimbursed to the players.

Mickey will deliver registration forms to all day cares in Wilson County on Monday.

Mickey needs a list of registration dates from each community by Tuesday, November 1. Please email to mgd39@wcyaa.org so Mickey can get it into the paper plus post it on each communities website.

Mickey will also run an ad on the "Big Dawg" radio station starting early next week.

The New Hope Sports Commission will host a Community Challenge on Friday, November 4, and Saturday, November 5. The profits will be used to fix the lights on field #1. The registration fee is \$15.00 per player with a \$2.00 gate admission for all adults including players per day. School age children will be admitted for a \$1.00 fee each day. Both men's and ladies' teams are welcome.

The Saratoga Youth Athletic Association will hold a 50/50 raffle on November 11th. See any S.Y.A.A. member for tickets.

Mickey suggested that the end of season basketball tournament admission prices be increased to \$2.00 for all adults including coaches and \$1.00 for all school age children (non-players in uniform).
