League Rules:

1. All Jersey must be worn properly (Jerseys tucked in).
2. All players must wear shin guards with socks covering shin guards.
3. No animals of any type are allowed inside gated area at Rock Ridge Elementary School Soccer Fields.
4. The State of North Carolina has outlawed the use of tobacco product on school premises. The WCYAA must enforce this law.
5. Parents must sit at the following areas:
 - Field #1 Sit next to the Softball Field
 - Field #2 Sit next to the wooded area
 - Field # 3 Sit next to the wooded area
6. Teams must have at least 5 players to start a game. A 5 minute grace period will start at game time and then a forfeit will be called if both teams do not have at least 5 player to play.
7. No Slide Tackling will be allowed in any age division. Penalty: player will be taken out of game by referee for two minutes. If same player is penalized twice for slide tackling in same game, he/she will be ejected from game. If a team has a player penalized for slide tackling and their team is now below 5 players then a forfeit will be called.
8. No Parents or Coaches are allowed on end lines or next to goals during game time.
9. Tournament Rules on Tie Breaker: a: Two 5 minute halves. Team with most goals wins; b: If teams are still tied game will go to penalty kicks (5 vs 5 High School Rules).
10. Regular Season games ending in a tie will not use any tie breakers.
11. All Rules not covered will revert to the NCHSAA Rulebook.
12. Sportsmanship is the key to having a great league. Therefore any unsportsmanlike actions will result in a minimum of a one game suspension for any player, coach, or fan with no appeal.
13. All Referee's judgment decisions are final. Rule violations can be protested to the referee at the time of discrepancy. Both teams must be notified at that time. A \$25.00 check made payable to the WCYAA must accompany a written protest letter to Mickey Davis, WCYAA Athletic Director within 24 hours after the end of the game. If the protest is upheld the \$25.00 check will be refunded. If the protest is rejected the \$25.00 will go into the WCYAA general fund.
