

## **Rock Ridge / W.C.Y.A.A. Complex Rules Updated:**

1. No coolers of any type will be allowed inside the complex. The W.C.Y.A.A. volunteers will furnish water, Gatorade, and cups in each dugout for each game. Large bags will be checked at the gates!
2. No food or drinks will be allowed inside the gated area at any point during the tournament.
3. Only handicapped vehicles with tags and managers (one car) will be allowed to park in "The Hole". Several large farmers use this area to get to their farms behind the wooded area. Also, baseballs are often hit over the fence and cars may be hit.
4. No pets of any kind or size will be allowed inside the gated area at the Onnie Cockrell Sports Complex at Rock Ridge Elementary School.
5. The Wilson County Sheriff's Department will patrol the grounds 24 hours a day during the World Series in an effort to everyone feel more comfortable.
6. Tents are allowed at each field but the W.C.Y.A.A. is not responsible for any lost or stolen tents left over night. No tents may be placed between the backstop fence and the bleachers.
7. Passes lost or stolen will not be replaced! Any person caught using a player or coach's pass will be ejected from the premises and not allowed to return.
8. Any parent or fan that is ejected from the games will not be allowed to return for the remainder of the World Series games. The World Series is about the players and good sportsmanship should be shown at all times!
9. One large commercial fan will be furnished in each dugout by the W.C.Y.A.A.
10. Each field will be worked completely between each World Series game. This includes watering, redoing the lines and batter boxes, painting the bases and raking.
11. Each team must clean out their dugout immediately after each game. Managers must sign the pitching affidavit immediately after the game also. Each field has a press box which will house the official scorekeeper and announcer. No other persons are allowed inside the pressbox except for the managers.
12. Practices will be allowed on the Field #2 World Series field everyday except for Saturday, August 14, and Sunday, August 15. The New Hope complex (two fields on hwy 58 North) will be used for practices. Practices will be set up through Mickey Davis on a first come basis. You may reach Mickey @ 252-230-2467 anytime. Practice area must be cleaned up after each practice.
13. Please help us keep the Rock Ridge/Onnie Cockrell Sports Complex clean. There are trash cans everywhere.
14. The Wilson County EMS is set up in the Rock Ridge Volunteer Fire Dept. building. Please keep everyone away from this building as the umpires and World Series Task Force will be set up there.

15. Please tell your parents and fans not to park on the Rock Ridge Fire Dept lot. There is a constant fear that someone might block in a fire truck that is needed urgently. If a vehicle is parked in that area, it will be towed at the owner's expense. Please note that this area will be blocked off by police tape.
16. Vendors will be set up at each field to sell items such as concessions, ball equipment, Dippin Dot Ice Cream, ect. The main concession stand is located at field #1 and bathrooms located behind the concession stand. Port a johns are located on field #2 and also at the bottom of the hill at field #2.
